Pledge of Allegiance led by Regina Kilgore

The minutes of the May 21, 2019 meeting were reviewed and there being no corrections, Alderwoman Anderson made motion to accept the minutes. Alderman Loper 2nd. A Voice Vote. Yeas: 6. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

The monthly bills were received and signed. Alderman Loper made motion to approve payment of the bills. Alderwoman McAlister 2nd. A Voice Vote. Yeas: 6. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.

Mayor Lee stated there is a meeting scheduled for Friday, June 21 with City Corp representatives and Richard Harris, Mayor of Russellville, to discuss reduction in the sewer rates for the City of Dover.

Mayor Lee asked the council to make a decision next month about whether or not to raise the Water/Sewer rates again.

Mayor Lee presented Resolution 2019-1, the Water and Sewer Budget for July 1, 2019 thru June 30, 2020. Alderman Loper made motion to accept the Resolution. Alderwoman McAlister 2nd. A Voice Vote. Yeas: 6. Nays: 0. Motion Carried.
